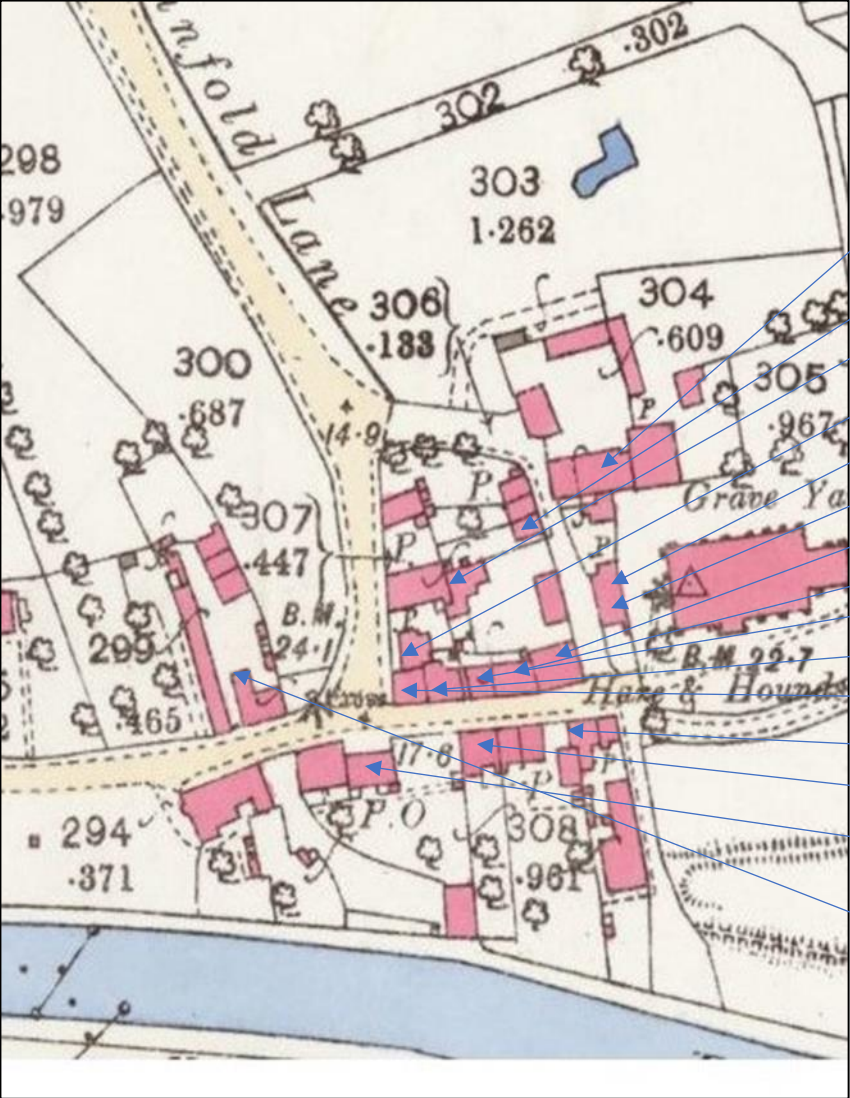


Fishlake History Society – Who Lived Where? A talk by Denis Wilcock on life in Fishlake in the 1940/50's – 10 October 2018

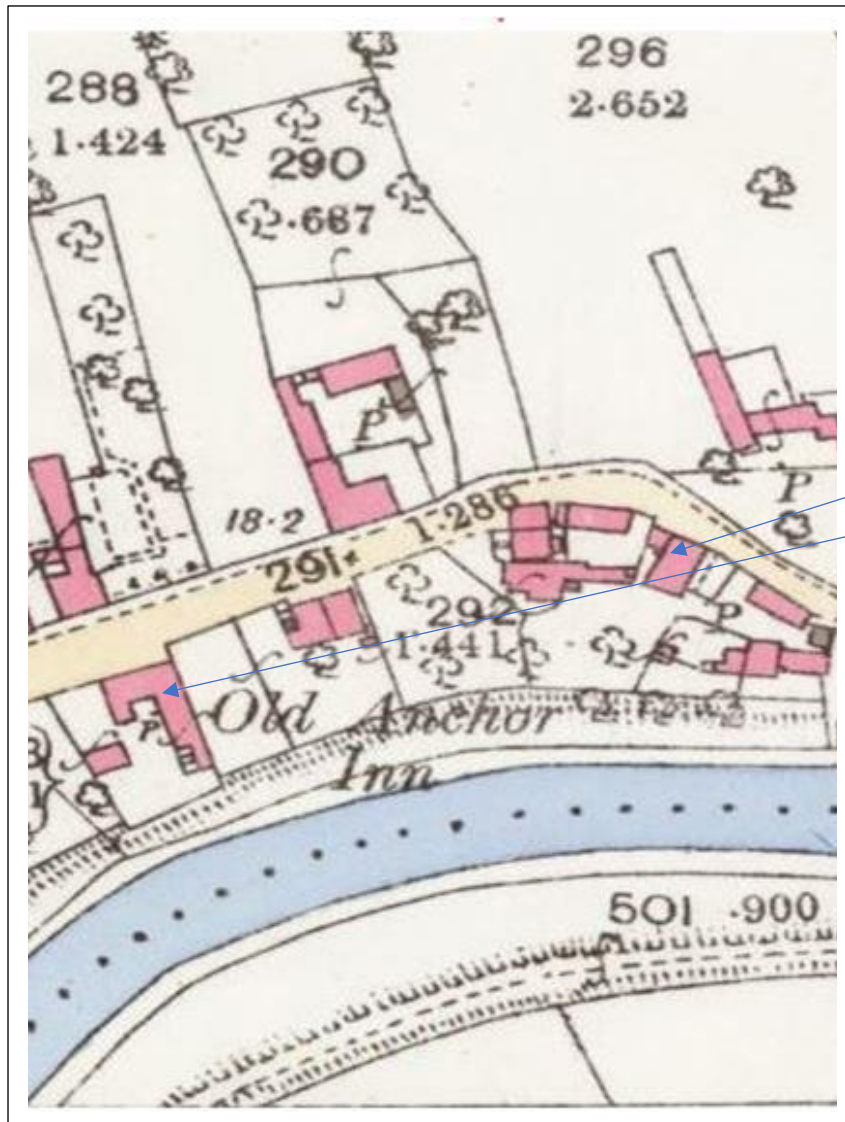

Tom Williams and Geordie Liddle from 1960's onwards. The plan shows the Old Anchor Inn which was demolished around 1900 and rebuilt on the same site

Further Notes – The Police House was at No. 2 Hay Green, occupied by PC Poole

Electricity was installed from the 1930's onwards

A piped water supply was installed between 1952 and 1956

Mains drainage was installed in 2001
